We are glad you are here today!!!

If you're worshipping with us for the first time today we want you to be as comfortable as possible. Here is some information about our church you might find helpful.

Worship Services

We celebrate communion each week. The cup and bread are passed to each row by our communion servers. Everyone who believes Jesus is Lord is welcome to share in communion. If you choose to take communion, simply partake of the bread and the cup as it is passed to you, and then pass both trays along to the next person.

Children & Middle School (ages 5-Grade 8)

During the 10:30 service, all children are welcome to come forward during the Children's Moment with the pastor. After Children's Moment the children *ages 5-Grade 4* exit through the back of the sanctuary for a time of worship, crafts, and story-telling in the Children's Worship Center at the top of the stairs on the second floor. *Grades 5 – 8* are invited to join a leader of the congregation in the Balcony for a time of discussion about our worship services.

Infants & Toddlers

Perhaps you have an infant or toddler up to 5 years old, Deborah Griffith, our paid nursery attendant would love to care for your child during church services and/or Sunday School. The nursery is located on the second floor at the end of the hallway. Children may be picked up after services. For your convenience, changing tables are located in both the Fellowship Hall and main floor women's restrooms, as well as in the nursery, on the second floor.

We would appreciate you taking the time to fill out the attendance card located in the pew back and leaving it on the pew seat. We promise we won't harass you, but if you leave your name, address, and email it helps us get to know you, and you can receive information about what happens here at Central Christian.
