

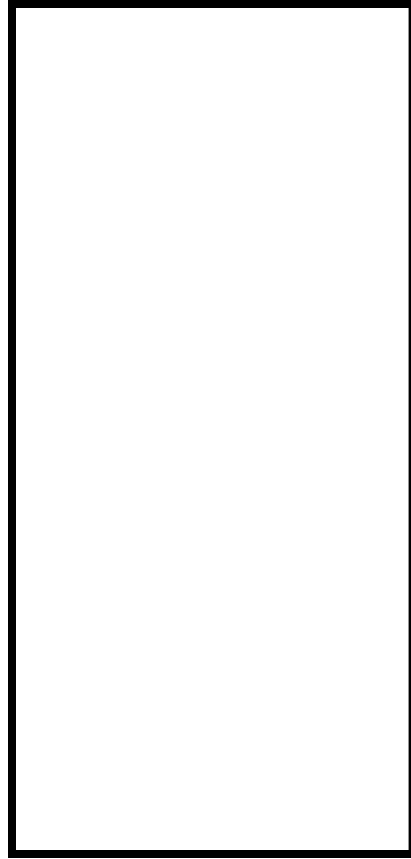

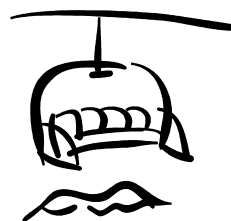


MISSION WORKSHOPS
